IMDG Code e-learning port tour comes to Felixstowe: 25/26 May 2010

Why you should attend

IMDG Code training became **mandatory** for all shore-side staff involved in dangerous goods transport by sea from January 2010. IMDG Code e-learning is a cost-effective training solution developed by Exis Technologies with the support of the International Maritime Organization. It addresses the urgent need to train large numbers of staff economically and with minimum disruption to normal working, and provides general awareness and function specific training specified in the IMDG Code.

Shore side sectors include:-

- Shippers and forwarders
- Container packers and consolidators

Compliance is required for staff in the above sectors with dangerous goods handling/shipping responsibilities.

- Packing of DG in packages
- Marking, labelling or placarding DG
- Packing/unpacking containers
- Preparing transport documents for DG
- Offering DG for transport
- Accepting DG for transport
- Handling DG in transport
- Carrying DG in transport
