



Destin8 Release Notes - Version 4.30.0

Change Requests:

DES-6950 – MCA/MAA/MAC – This change converts amalgamated UCNs to 14 digits. All amalgamations will now be 14 digits, rather than 9; where the UVI is always followed by the same 4 digits - 9999 - and a further 5 digits. e.g. 12345 9999 00001 (spaces for illustration only). DES- 8099 – COPARN – Amend business rules to permit a zero-weight value for empties. A change has been made to provide a sleeker solution for empty weights declared.

DES-7642 – IEQ has now been decommissioned. All import enquiries now require the use of transaction INQ. IEQ is no longer available.

Issues:

DES-5518 – MCS – This resolves the issue whereby the number of packages was validated against the total manifested as opposed to the devanned total if the devan is complete.

DES-5851 – COREOR – Fixed a Vessel Matching Problem if vessel departed and no UVI supplied within the message.

DES-7567 – COPARN – Fixed an issue which allowed a negative Nett Weight where VGM is provided under Tare Weight.

This release contains a total of 54 Change Requests, Minor Improvements and Fixes to reported issues, some of which are not specified as they may be directly related to the Destin8 infrastructure or do not impact externally.
